## Code of Conduct

### **Expected Behavior**

- All participants are treated with respect and consideration, valuing a diversity of views and opinions.

### **Unacceptable Behavior**

- Verbal or written abuse of participant will not be tolerated.
- Examples of unacceptable behavior include but are not limited to verbal or written comments related to gender, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, religion, national origin, inappropriate use of nudity and/or sexual images in public spaces or in presentations, and threatening or stalking any participant.
- Anyone requested to stop unacceptable behavior is expected to comply immediately. Staff may take any action deemed necessary and appropriate, including immediate removal from the meeting without warning.
